








Amazing fish facts

- A group of fish is called a 'shoal'
- There are at least 20,000 different species of fish in the world
- Fish breathe by taking oxygen from the water using their gills

<p>Common Blenny or Shanny</p>  <p>Look for the long dorsal fin along the whole of their back</p>	<p>Rock Goby</p>  <p>Look for two dorsal fins, the first with a yellow tinge</p>	<p>Butterfish</p>  <p>Look for big spots on its back. It is very slippery</p>
<p>Rockling</p>  <p>Look for 3 or 5 barbels, like whiskers, on its chin</p>	<p>Pipe fish</p>  <p>This is long and thin with small fins on its back</p>	<p>?</p> <p>Did you find any different fish?</p>

Remember: lift rocks or seaweed carefully and always return them to the same position. If you want to put a fish in your bucket to have better look, make sure there is enough water for it to swim. When you have looked at a fish always pop it back where you found it.
